

☐ Licensed and insured in Ontario	
\square Established business with years of experience	
☐ Positive online reviews and references	
☐ Bonus: Provides a physical address	
STEP 2: Ask About Sealant Quality	
\square Avoid oil based or shiny/glossy sealants—they wear faster and can be slippery	
\square Proprietary or professional-grade products preferred over retail/D.I.Y. options	
\square 3-5 year expected durability for sealcoat	
\square Bonus: Commercial-grade sealant suitable for Ontario's climate	
STEP 3: Confirm Proper Preparation & Equipment	
\square Evaluates driveway to see if it is a candidate for sealcoating using pictures/site vi	sit
\square Cracks are to be repaired first with kettle not caulking gun	
\square Cleans driveway with a blower	
\square Uses an adequate squeegee and spray system (not bucket) for spreading sealco	at
STEP 4: Evaluate the Application Process	
\square Professional equipment used for estate driveways (sprayer wand/ride-on sprayer))
\square Offers multiple passes for even coverage	
\square Scheduling accounts for weather to ensure proper curing	PG ·
